REGISTRATION POLICIES

Please read before registering. You are responsible for the information below.

- In the past we have allowed a 15 minute "grace period" for trainees who are running late, we will no longer allow that grace period. Going forward **NO** late arrivals will be accepted into the training.
- Parking lot gate & doors will lock at 6:30 PM on Tuesdays & Thursdays and at 9:00 AM on Saturdays
- We will be reviewing basic safety procedures at the beginning of each training session.
- Admission to trainings will begin at 6:15 PM on Tuesdays & Thursdays and at 8:45 AM on Saturdays.

Training Policy

- Pre-registration is **REQUIRED** 3 days prior to all training sessions.

- Admission to trainings will begin 15 minutes prior to your session for sign-in.
- Doors and parking lot gate are locked during training. If you arrive after the session begins, you **WILL NOT** be allowed in.
- Substitutes are allowed. You are responsible for calling the office **at least 24 hours prior** to your session if you cannot attend. **If you do not call, you are considered a NO SHOW.**
- Children are **NOT** allowed in the building during training.
- You **MUST** attend the entire training to receive your certificate.
- You **MUST** provide a **48 Hour-Notice** if you need to cancel or change a registration for CPR & First Aid. If we do not receive a notice and you are considered a **NO SHOW**, you will be responsible for the cost of the class spot.

Training sessions are **FREE** to Type I, II and III Child Care Centers, the general public, CCAP Registered Family Child Care Home Providers, and CCAP Registered In-Home Providers (unless otherwise noted).
